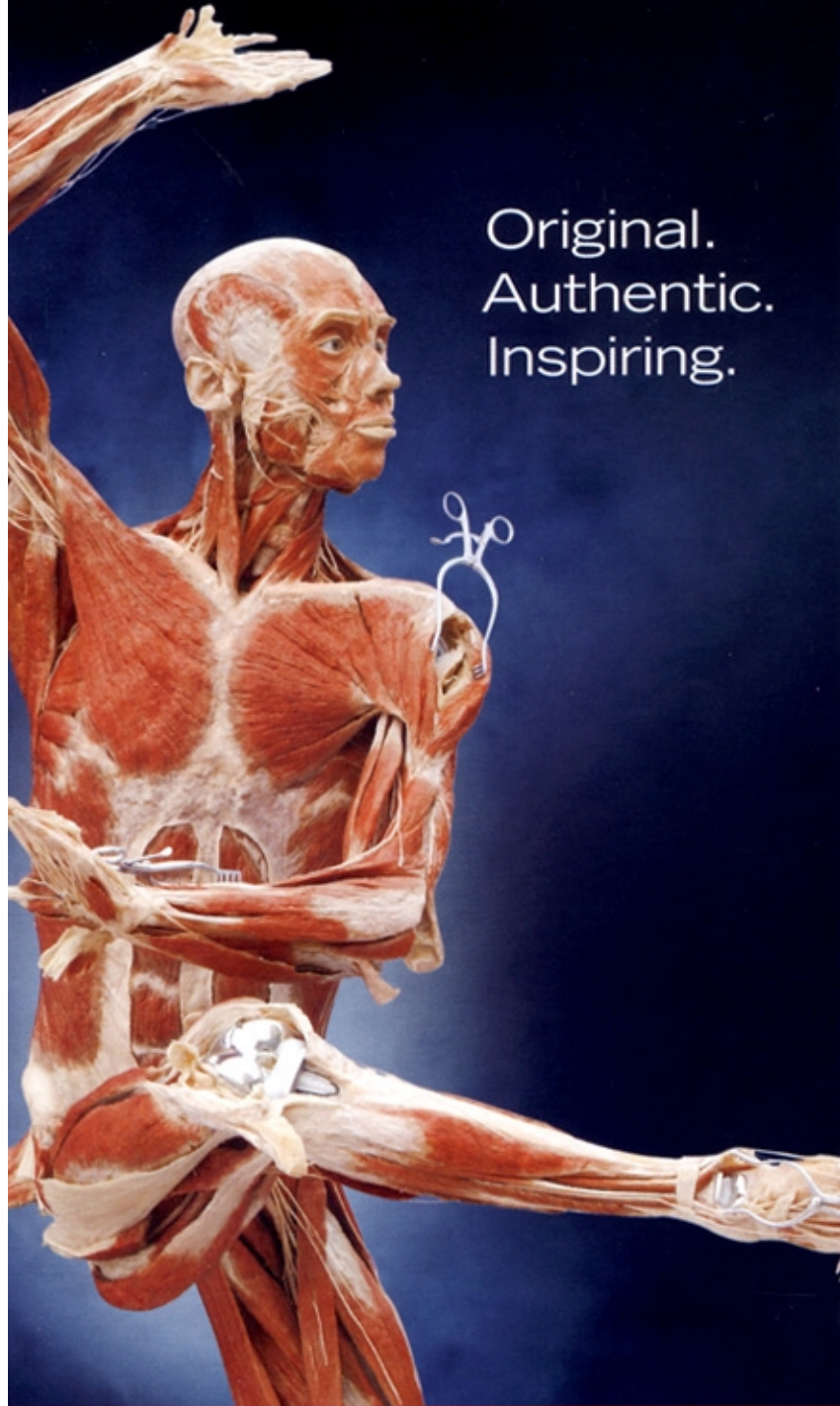

Visitors to **BODY WORLDS** experience the power and vulnerability of the wondrous human body. Authentic specimens convey the intricacies and individuality of the body that simply don't translate with constructed models. Most striking are the exhibit's whole-body plastinates—many displayed in dynamic poses. The wide range of specimens show how the body works when it is healthy and how it breaks down when it is not. Compare healthy lungs with those of a smoker, a disease-free liver with one showing hepatocirrhosis, and a slice of a normal human body with that of an obese body that shows fat tissue and its relentless ability to shorten life.
